Conditions of Enrolment

- Teachers and schedules are subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances
- The use of digital recording devices including cell phones with cameras and video capability is strictly prohibited at all times.
- **There are no refunds except in the case of cancellation due to insufficient registration.**
- There is a \$20 registration fee payable on the initial registration in each school year.
- The School of Dance will contact the registrant to confirm residence and communication details.
- No refunds for classes cancelled due to circumstances beyond our control (eg. legislated closure/inclement weather etc.)
- Release of Liability and Assumption of Risk Waiver must be signed and dated in order to be eligible to take part in classes.
- Fees for the course selected are due in full at the time of registration.
- The School accepts payments by VISA, Mastercard, cheques, money-orders, and e-transfers.
- Cheques returned from the bank for any reason are subject to a \$50 administration charge.
- The School reserves the right to ask disruptive individuals to leave the premises and/or not to serve a customer.
- The School of Dance is not responsible for students before and after class.
- The School of Dance is not responsible for lost items.
- I consent to the use of archival photographs and/or video footage of my child as part of the image bank and marketing of The School of Dance.

The School of Dance is committed to protecting personal information by following responsible information handling practices, in keeping with privacy laws. We collect and use personal data in order to better meet your service needs, to ensure the safety of our participants, for statistical purposes, to inform you about The School of Dance programme or service in which you are registered, to complete payment transactions and to satisfy government and regulatory obligations. You may also hear from us periodically about other The School of Dance programmes, services and opportunities that may interest and benefit you. We do not rent, sell or trade our mailing lists. If you wish to be removed from our email or mailing list, please contact The School's Administration at any time.

The School of Dance – Procedure for Entering and Exiting the Building/General Information

Before entering The School at the beginning of September 2020, every student must submit the signed waiver provided by The School.

Prior to arriving at The School of Dance, we ask that all students fully prepare to dance. This entails having hair done, dance attire on underneath their street clothes, feet prepared for pointe work (if applicable), and dance shoes easily accessible in one bag to limit extra clothing items being brought into the dance space. This will make for an efficient transition of people entering and exiting the space.

Only registered students may enter the building to reduce cross-over contamination and to maintain appropriate physical distancing requirements before and after scheduled class times. Class start and end times will be staggered to limit the number of students in a common space at the same time.

Students must be masked to enter The School of Dance. Students will be allowed entry just prior to their class times and will be asked to leave quickly after their class is over.

All individuals will be screened at the entrance. An administrator will record a verbal confirmation that the dancer is asymptomatic. Entry will be denied to any person who has any of the symptoms outlined below, and they will be directed home and instructed to contact their health care provider. We will ask:

Q - Do you have a confirmed case of COVID-19 or have you had close contact with anyone with a confirmed case of COVID-19?

Q – Have you travelled outside of Canada in the past 14 days or had close contact with anyone who has?

Q – Have you had close contact with anyone with an acute respiratory illness?

Q – Do you have any of the following symptoms:

- Fever/temperature
- New onset of cough
- Worsening chronic cough
- Shortness of breath
- Difficulty breathing
- Sore throat
- Difficulty swallowing
- Decrease or loss of sense of taste or smell
- Chills
- Headaches
- Unexplained fatigue/malaise/muscle aches
- Nausea/vomiting, diarrhea, abdominal pain
- Pink eye (conjunctivitis)
- Runny nose/nasal congestion without other known cause

Once inside, students will be asked to disinfect their hands. All outdoor belongings (shoes, jackets, dance bags, et cetera) will be placed in plastic bags provided by The School and these bags will be taken by the student to the classroom and stored in a designated spot. The bags will be taken home by the students for disposal.

Waiting areas are closed and students who are about to enter their class will stand at the space markers placed in the common areas to ensure two metre physical distancing requirements are adhered to at all times.

Once students are able to enter the studio, they will go directly to their place at the barre, or their square in the centre of the room. While in the studio, students must stay in their designated area unless otherwise instructed by the teacher. If a student needs to use the washroom or leave the studio for any reason, they must ask the teacher and follow their instructions. Hand disinfectant must be used before entering the classroom.

Dancers must have their own equipment. Sharing of personal items including food and water bottles is strictly prohibited. Water fountains, lockers, and dressing rooms will not be in use.

All students from Junior Ballet 1 up require their own, rolled yoga mat.

Parents/guardians are advised to wait with students until the designated drop off time outside of the building, and to meet their student outside the building after class at the designated time. Children's safe exiting of the building to a parent/guardian will be monitored by staff of The School. Classrooms are sanitized and reset between classes so strict adherence to the schedules is a must.

The School of Dance will be locked.

All registration and general communications with The School will be done by email or phone.
